BRITTON LANGDON, JR.

Born in Johnston County, North Carolina in 1832, Britton Langdon, Jr. was the son of Britton Langdon, Sr. and Margaret “Peggy” Carroll. He married Margaret Delaney Adams, born, April 4th, 1835, daughter of Joseph and Talitha Johnson Adams. Together they had two children, Edith Ann Langdon, born November 5th, 1856 and Joseph Marion Langdon, born August 21st, 1860.

Britton enlisted in Company C, 5th Infantry Regiment North Carolina on July 15th, 1862. He died of pneumonia on April 10th, 1863 in Scottsville, VA.

I certify that the within named Britton
Langston, a private of Capt. C. C. Cuthbert's (C.) 5th
N. C. Troop was enrolled by Major Mallett at
Raleigh N. Carolina on the 15th day of July 1862 to
serve for 3 years or the war; died of Pneumonia
on the 10th day of April 1863, at Scottsville Va.

The said private Britton Langston was last paid
by Capt. J. M. Jones to include the 28th day of February
1863, and has pay due from that date to the 10th
day of April 1863.

He was not indebted to the Confederate States.
