DANIEL STARLING

Born in Johnston County, North Carolina about 1840, Daniel Starling was the son of Elisha and Margaret Milliner Starling. On December 10th, 1867, he married Sophronia Peedin, born, about 1853.

Together they had at least eight children, Ella Starling, born about 1877, Rufus Starling, born September 3rd, 1880, Luther Starling, born June 7th, 1883, Walter Starling, born 1885, Fred Starling, born about 1888, Minnie Starling, born about 1890, Myrtie Starling, born December 3rd, 1892, and Octavia Starling, born about 1897.

Daniel enlisted in Company E, 50th Infantry Regiment North Carolina on April 29th, 1862.
