Beasley Loses Battle With Cancer

A pillar in the Coats community has passed on. Former town board member Max Beasley died Thursday morning after battling cancer for several months. He was 77. Mr. Beasley served the board as commissioner for 12 years before calling it quits last year. He decided not to run for re-election due to his failing health.

[&]quot;It's a big loss to the community and his family," said B.W. Holland, a close friend and

another former town commissioner. "He was a great friend and a mentor to me. It's truly going to be a loss, but at least he won't suffer anymore," Mr. Holland said.

Mr. Beasley lived at 323 E. Main St. in Coats with his wife Dovie Davis Beasley. He had one son, Max Duane of Goldsboro, and three grandchildren, Zabrina, Susan and Stephanie.

He served at Coats First Baptist Church as a deacon and retired after 30 years of employment with GMAC. He also served in the Navy. However, it was his involvement in Coats politics and town business for which he was most well known. He was respected for his strong convictions and belief in the betterment of the town.

Gale Spears served on the board with Mr. Beasley for eight years and considered him a friend.

"He loved Coats and he was always concerned with the well being of the residents of this city," she said. "He was a joy to work with; he is really going to be missed, I'll tell you that." She said he had strong opinions about how town business should be conducted. "Max and I sometimes didn't agree on everything, but we had a very good working relationship and he was one that would quickly say 'I was wrong, you were right' and we both did that the time we were on the board together, which was about eight years," she said. "We had a very respectful working relationship because we both had the same goal and that was to do what is best for the Town of Coats."

Johnny Shull, the former mayor of Coats when Mr. Beasley was serving on the board, also respected him for taking a stand.

"It was certainly an honor to serve with Max, and while he and I certainly had our disagreements on policy and political decisions, he was a fine man and certainly he and I worked well together and I greatly respected him," he said. Mr. Shull recalled the first time he got a taste of how concerned Mr. Beasley was with the well being of Coats. "My best memory of Max was that he invited me over to his house right after we got elected on a Saturday morning and we probably spent six or seven hours together talking about issues," he said.

Mr. Holland explained just how much influence and impact Mr. Beasley had during his years in Coats.

"He has left a good legacy," he said. "He is the one who got sewer in town, he had a big part in that and of course he worked hand in hand with a lot of people with the Centennial Square. Max did a lot of things for the community most people didn't even know about," Mr. Holland said.

Donation Of Time, Energy

Gayle Sorrell, who helped head up the Cenntenial Project, said Mr. Beasley donated his time, energy and talent of painting to spruce up sites during last year's Cenntenial celebration. She said he painted the mural of Alton Stewart (the late Coats aviator) on a wall downtown and also painted a mural on a wall in the museum. She said his talent was God-given and he never charged for it.

"That man cannot be described with just a few little words," Mrs. Sorrell said. "I guess the

thing I think about Max, because he was out here so much with the Cenntenial, is that he was a true Southern gentleman." She said instead of spending his retirement relaxing, he decided to move back to his hometown and better it. "This is a man that went away, had a very high position and decided he should serve Coats," she said. "He had nothing to gain except to love his community."

Though he never had the privilege of serving with Mr. Beasley, Marshall Miller, the current Coats mayor, knew him and his legacy.

"I was very saddened by today's news," Mayor Miller said Thursday. "I had gone recently and seen Max and it was a surprise to me, because when I saw him he looked good, and they were planning on sending him home. I think that Coats lost a great citizen and the town is not going to be the same without him," he said.

Coats Scouts Better The Town Gregory Phillips

Three members of the 779th Boy Scouts of America Troop celebrated a special milestone in Coats Sunday. They're brothers, and all three made Eagle Scout. The Parrish brothers - Joshua Henry, 21, Jonas McLuin, 20, and Simon Bartholomew, 18 - went through their Eagle Scout Court of Honor together at Coats Baptist Church Saturday afternoon.

With the requirements having to be met by the scout's 18th birthday, Joshua and Simon could have been recognized earlier but agreed to wait for their younger brother to achieve the honor so they could celebrate as a family. Their Scoutmaster Kevin Pope said he doesn't think the Parrish boys' accomplishment has been matched very often.

"I have had several people say that they had remembered seeing a triple like that," he said. "I had two brothers and two of us are Eagle Scouts and the other one didn't get there, so I think that's kind of a rare thing."

Troop 779 has stayed strong in Coats, with an enrollment of about 25 boys ever since Mr. Pope was a scout in the same troop as a boy, back when his father Gail Pope was Scoutmaster.

"I remember several of the trips that we took, and really more than anything else just learning to be a leader," he said.

Community Project

In addition to the numerous merit badges required, Eagle Scouts must also complete a community project to make the grade and Coats has done well out of its local troops' efforts. Joshua Parrish resurfaced and repainted the dilapidated tennis courts at the Coats Park, which he said "had been neglected for years and years." Jonas took the bell and cornerstones from the old Coats School and installed them outside the new school.

"My dad had always wanted one of us to do that," he said.

Simon restored a century-old cotton gin for display the new Coats Cotton Museum, opened at the town's centennial celebration three months ago.

"I learned a lot of the history while I was doing it," he said.

Other Eagle Scout projects have also benefited the town, from the steps installed at the Coasts Senior Center by Mr. Pope's son Matthew to the a storm drain installed at the park to create a picnic area by Ryan Pope (no relation). Another Scout, Chris Grimes, resurfaced and painted the parking lot at the park, Mr. Pope said, and the town appreciates the effort.

"The Coats chamber and the commissioners express that quite often to us," Mr. Pope said. "It's been a good area to work with, I have a lot of good parents that I work with now."

Mr. Parrish said the troop has always had good leadership. Mr. Pope said the community support has driven the troop and that the parents deserve most of the credit.

"The parents take care of the books and the registrations and records," he said. "All I have to do is take the boys to the woods."

Those camping trips seem to be a key to the troop's popularity. Mr. Pope said he tries to take them camping every month and all three Parrish boys cited those trips as a favorite memory of their time in the troop.

"That's the key," Mr. Pope said.

Between them, the Parrish boys amassed 130 merit badges. Jonas leads the pack, with 52.

"I just think I went to more camps that they did," he said. There's enough competitive spirit between them that once Joshua had made Eagle Scout, his brothers' were determined to follow.

"The other two knew they had to do it too," Mr. Parrish said.

Mr. Parrish never made it as far in the Scouts as his boys have.

"I dropped out before I made First Class Scout," he said.

For Mr. Parrish and his wife Judy, Saturday's ceremony forced them to confront their boys' passage into adulthood, all at once.

"My job's done," Mr. Parrish said. "They've definitely achieved a lot."
