


TROY PARRISH

Born in North Carolina about 1830, Troy Parrish was the son of James and Elizabeth "Betsy" Jones Parrish. On January 8th, 1851, he married Mary Parrish, born about 1824, daughter of Johnson and Martha "Patsey" Stevenson Parrish.

Together they had six children, John Randell Parrish, born 1851, Calvin Haywood Parrish, born January 19, 1856, Ezekial Manly Parrish, born October 5th, 1857, Patsy Parrish, born about 1857, Matilda Jane "Tilda" Parrish, born about 1860, and Martha A. Parrish, born about 1862.

Troy enlisted in Company I, 24th Infantry Regiment North Carolina on July 15th, 1862. He was captured on June 17th, 1864 at Petersburg, VA. Confined on June 24th, 1864 at Point Lookout, MD. Transferred on July 27th, 1864 to Elmira, NY. Took the Oath of Allegiance on May 29th, 1865.



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


* This regiment was organized with nine companies in July, 1861. Company D was added in May, 1862, when the regiment was re-organized for the war.

The designation of the regiment was changed from the 14th Regiment North Carolina Infantry (Volunteers) to the 24th Regiment North Carolina Infantry (State Troops) by S. O. No. 222, A. & I. G. O., dated November 14, 1861.

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
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
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
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
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
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
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
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
